SUPPLICATIONS FOR RETIRING TO BED

قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ أَحَدٌ... × 3

قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ النَّاسِ... × 3

'Aishah narrates: "Whenever Allah's Messenger ﷺ retired to bed, he would blow (without spittle) into his hands, recite Surah Ikhlāas (112), Surah al-Falaq (113), and Surah an-Naas (114) into them, and then wipe his hands over his whole body, starting from his head and going down as far as he could. He would repeat this three times."

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ...

Abu Hurairah (RA) was guarding the charity when a man tried to steal food for three consecutive nights. Each time he pleaded poverty and Abu Hurairah (RA) let him go, though the Prophet ﷺ warned every night that he would return. On the third night, when Abu Hurairah (RA) caught him again and insisted on taking him to the Prophet ﷺ. Upon hearing this warning, the person told Abu Hurairah (RA) that if you let me free, then I will teach you such words that if you read them daily when retiring to the bed, then Almighty Allah will benefit you and Almighty Allah will appoint a guardian for you and the devil will not be able to come close to you. He then taught him Ayat al-Kursi. The next morning, the Prophet ﷺ confirmed the benefit of Ayat al-Kursi and revealed that the man was actually the devil in human form.

Abu Mas'ud al-Badri narrated that the Allah's Messenger ﷺ said: "Whoever recites the last two verses of Surah al-Baqarah at night, they will suffice him (and protect him from all harm)."

Abu Hurairah (RA) reported that Fatima (RA) came to the Messenger of Allah ﷺ and asked for a servant because household work was difficult for her. The Prophet ﷺ said, "I cannot give you a servant, but shall I tell you something better than a servant? When you go to bed, say Subhanallah thirty-three times, Alhamdulillah thirty-three times, and Allahu Akbar thirty-four times."
